



### **Addressing COVID Concerns**

As a mother of three I truly understand the apprehension felt with placing your child outside of your home during these uncertain times. The gauge I have always used has been what my comfort level would be if it were my child. I am providing you with a list of precautionary measures I have taken to help you transition your child into our community.

- Masks are worn by both staff and children ages two and up for the entire time that they are on the premises.
- Sanitation has and remains a top priority.
- Temperature and oxygen readings are taken daily for staff members and children.
- Only staff members are allowed in the building.
- Should we have to admit a repair person or licensing agent onto the premises, their temperature and oxygen level are taken as well.
- Windows are open throughout the day for ventilation.
- Touch spots are labeled as a reminder for sanitation of the spot or your hands.
- The number of children per classroom is limited to the state mandated count.
- Children are socially distanced while napping and eating.
- Playground equipment is sanitized between uses.
- Toys are sanitized throughout the day.
- Toys are not to be brought in from home.
- Toys which cannot be sanitized immediately are not being used at this time.
